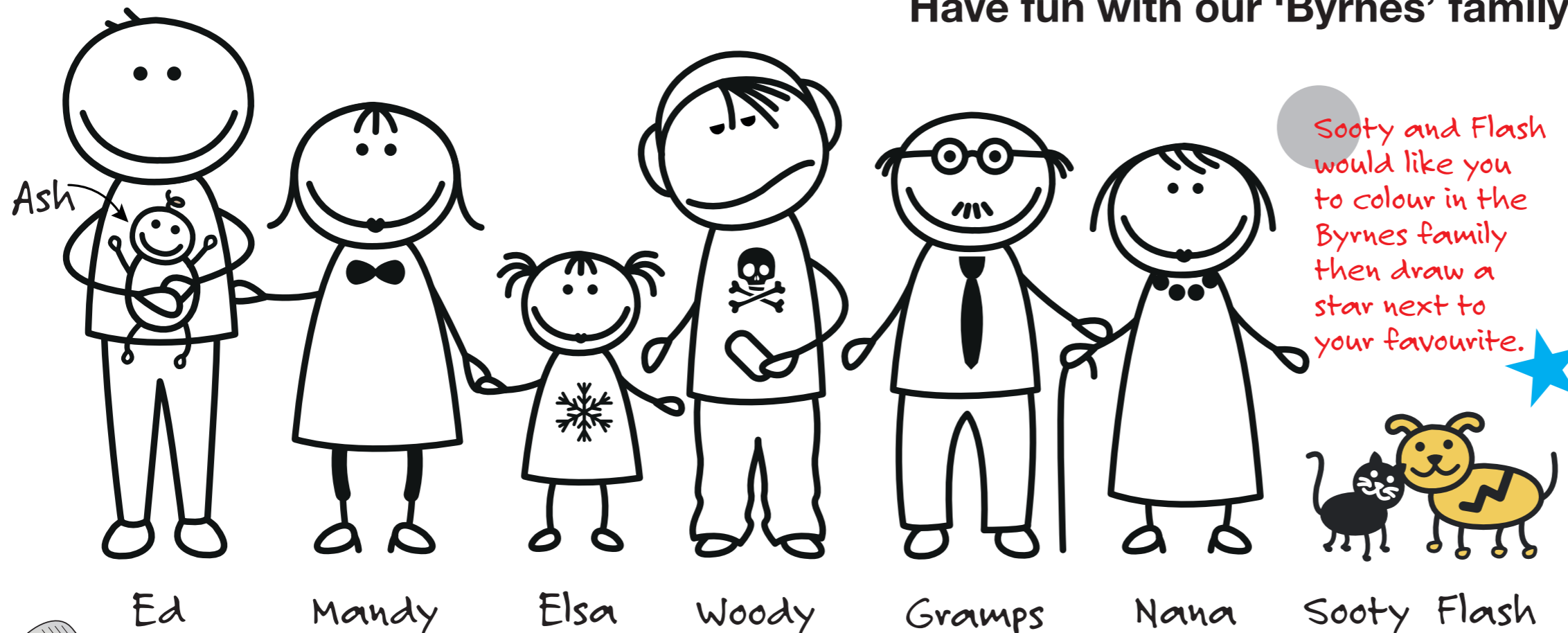


The Byrnes family activity sheet

Have fun with our 'Byrnes' family

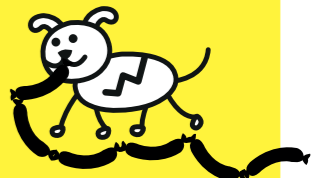


Sooty and Flash would like you to colour in the Byrnes family then draw a star next to your favourite.



Keep your family fire safe, please follow these top tips.

- NEVER play with matches or lighters – if you see matches or lighters lying around tell a grown up straight away.
- Stay well away from hot barbecues and bonfires – you could get hurt if you get too close. Make sure other children and pets stay away too!
- Keep away even after a fire is out – they can stay very hot for a long time.
- If your clothes catch fire, remember: **STOP** where you are, **DROP** to the ground, **ROLL** around to put the fire out

- If someone gets burnt, remember:



- Learn how to dial **999** in an emergency.
- Remind adults that they must keep their attention on the barbecue all the time when it is in use.
- Don't distract grown-ups when they are cooking or looking after a bonfire – they might not notice if the fire gets out of control.
- If you notice a fire has spread:

MOVE AWAY quickly and **STAY AWAY SHOUT OUT** and tell a **GROWN UP**
