

Emergency!



This guidance supports teachers in leading a structured discussion that helps children plan and create a story based on an emergency situation. Through teacher-led conversation, questioning, and shared ideas, students are encouraged to explore what emergencies are, how people respond to them, and how people might think and feel during an emergency.

<p>Teacher to read the sentence prompt aloud and give students the options.</p> <p>"Today, we are going to imagine that we are at _____, and something unexpected happens."</p>	<p>Give students the option of one of the listed emergencies.</p> <p>"Suddenly, _____"</p> <p>Remind students "An emergency is when something happens and we need special people trained to care."</p>	<p>Ask students "How might we feel when something unexpected happens?"</p> <p>Note down their answers.</p> <p>Explain "It is okay to feel that way. What is the most important thing we should do first?"</p> <p>Guide them towards: Stay calm and tell a grown-up.</p>	<p>Ask students: "When there is an emergency, who should we go to?"</p> <p>Remind students what number to call in an emergency.</p> <p>Ask students to name the emergency services that can be called and which is best to call (based on the emergency chosen)</p>	<p>Remind students "The emergency services have special people trained to care"</p> <p>Explain to students that we only call 999 in an emergency</p> <p>Discuss each non-emergency below and ask students who can help them (their grown-ups)</p> <p>This is important to recognise the difference between emergencies and emotional situations for children</p>
