

Bonfire & Firework Safety: Key Stage 1

<u>Cut out flashcards</u>

Provide each student with a sheet of flashcards.

- Encourage students to cut out each flashcard on the dotted lines.
- Once cut out, students can sort each card into "hot" or "cold" items.
- Develop games such as: snap, memory game, spot the difference etc.
- The cards are a great opportunity to discuss safety around bonfires and fireworks. Also, to remind students of the importance of calling 999 in an emergency.

Circle time

Using the larger flashcards, in-cooperate them into a circle time discussion.

 As a class, organise the cards into "hot" and "cold" items.

Once organised discuss safety questions such as:

- What should you wear on your hands if you are holding a sparkler?
- What should you do with a sparkler when it has gone out?
- You must never touch fireworks. Why not?
- Why should you stand a safe distance from the bonfire?

Why is it important to be careful around HOT items?


















